The purpose of UFRJ's International Relations

Office (SGRI, in Portuguese) is to work for the


internationalization of the university in favor of its students, professors, and

administrative staff.

As UFRJ's main mediator, SGRI creates a dialogue with academic institutions abroad, such as universities and research institutes, with government bodies, such as embassies and consulates, and also with international agencies.



In addition to creating international partnerships, SGRI also maintains a national network, which includes the Ministry of Education (MEC)/Office of Higher Education (SESu), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and funding agencies such as the Coordination for the Improvement of Higher Education Personnel (CAPES) and the National Council for Scientific and Technological Development (CNPq).



On July 1st, 2022 the University Council published Resolution 77, which defines the guidelines and objectives of the internationalization policy for the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro.



INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS

UFRJ establishes cooperation agreements and other types of partnerships with hundreds of foreign higher education institutions.


The signed agreements inform, among ther things, the rights and duties of students who intend to exchange.

Although the terms of cooperation agreements vary from one university to another, they generally ensure that UFRJ students:



- receive a student visa in their passport, which allows them to enroll in a foreign university and stay abroad for the necessary period;
- do not pay tuition fees at the foreign university;
- take advantage, at UFRJ, of the credits obtained at the foreign university.

INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Mobility at UFRJ is only possible for students from partner institutions. Individual applications are not taken into account.
- ✓ All courses are taught in Portuguese.
- ✓ A certificate of proficiency in Portuguese is not required, but level A2 is recommended.
- ✓ The partner institutions are responsible for their student's appointment and application.
- ✓ People with dual citizenship (Brazilian + foreign citizenship) must apply as Brazilians and provide all mandatory documentation.
- Foreigners who study at UFRJ for one full semester must have a student visa.
- ✓ The step-by-step guide for the appointment and application process is available at internacional.ufrj.br/incoming.
